Course Outline for Y10

Students will spend the first half of the year developing their instrumental skills and the skills associated with working in a band. Students will then complete the Controlled Assessment Unit, Live Music Performance in April/May 2016.

Weightings:

Coursework: MUSPRA 209 and MUSPRA 231

Controlled Assessment Coursework: MUSPRA 230

What students should be doing to achieve:

- Attend all lessons,
- Attend your instrumental lessons,
- Complete all homework tasks,
- Practice on your instrument towards both the MUSPRA 230 unit, your graded Music exam and the Music Theory work.
- Take an active part in extra-curricular activities in the department.

How parents / carers can help students achieve:

- Ask your son/daughter to show you the rsl-atm.co.uk website. This shows all assessment information, formative feedback and final assessment grades as units are completed.
- Encourage your son/daughter to attend their instrumental lessons.
- Encourage your son/daughter to take additional graded exams in Music Theory and instrumental exams.
- Attend any performances which your son/daughter performs in.
