Course Outline for Y10

Students will spend the first half of the year developing their skills on the Reason software completing a criteria based assignment. Students will then complete the Controlled Assessment Unit, Live Sound Recording in April/May 2016.

What students should be doing to achieve:

- Attend all lessons,
- Attend your instrumental lessons,
- Complete all homework tasks,
- Practice using the Reason software and recording studio outside of class hours
- Take an active part in extra-curricular activities in the department.

- Encourage your son/daughter to attend their instrumental lessons.

- Attend any performances which your son/daughter performs in.
