



***Graig Shakespeare has been appointed
Leicester City manager until the end of the
season.***

The 53-year-old has been in caretaker charge since Claudio Ranieri was sacked on 23 February, nine months after winning the Premier League title, Shakespeare he has never managed full-time. Leicester have won their games with him in charge.

Leicester host Seville in the second leg of their last-16 Champions League tie on Tuesday. The Spanish side won the first leg 2-1. Shakespeare will take charge of the final 11 games of their Premier League campaign and will start his official reign as boss at Tuesday night's Champions League last-16 second-leg tie against Seville at the King Power Stadium. 72% of people voted for Shakespeare to be given the job until the end of the season and 20% wanted him to get the job permanently.
