As part of their personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education lessons, all students take part in a series of sex and relationship education (SRE) lessons. These lessons will encompass the changing nature of a range of relationships, including friendship, family relationships and intimate relationships. As students move up through the school these themes are developed in an age-appropriate way.

SRE is a compulsory in all state schools under section 404 of the Education Act 1996 and a copy of our agreed SRE policy is available at your request and published on the school website.

The purpose of SRE at The City of Leicester College is: to prepare pupils for the physical and emotional changes of growing up; to give them the knowledge and skills to make informed and healthy choices; to build their confidence and skills to deal with situations they may encounter; to help them to stay safe and know where and how to ask for help if needed.

At times, carefully chosen external visitors and speakers may contribute to the programme. In these cases, lesson content will be agreed in advance and visitors will always be supervised by a member of school staff.

If you have concerns or would like to discuss the matter further, then please contact me. If you do not contact me by 5th March 2018 we will assume that you give consent for your child to attend these lessons
