Course Outline for Y11:

Year 11 started their GCSE maths in year 10. They will soon be beginning revision in preparation for their exams. They will be sitting 2 written papers in the summer exam period.

Weightings:

100% written examination

Paper 1 Non-Calculator (Foundation 1h 15m, Higher 1h 30m)

Paper 2 Calculator (Foundation 1h 45m, Higher 2h)

What students should be doing to achieve:

- Attending all lessons
- Completing all work set (Classwork and Homework)
- Coming to enrichment after school every Thursday prepared with questions and topics that they need to work on.
- Taking onboard and acting upon feedback.

How parents / carers can help students achieve:

- Remind students of enrichment after school every Thursday.
- Communicate with both teachers and students.
- Monitor a students organization and ensure that they are using their revision guide effectively.
