SENDIASS stands for Special Educational Needs and Disability Information Advice and Support Service. We were formally called the Parent Partnership service and have been supporting parents and carers in Leicester City since 1999.

Who we support

At SENDIASS we can provide information and advice for:

- Parents and carers of children and young people with SEND aged 0–25 in Leicester City who are concerned about their child/young persons educational progress
- Children and young people aged 0-25 in Leicester City with SEND who are concerned about the educational progress they are making or the support they are receiving

What we do

We can offer advice and information on key issues such as:

- School support and special educational provision
- Education, Health and Care Needs Assessments and Plans
- Local policy, practice and the Local Offer
- Social care and health in relation to a young person's SEND

We can also provide practical support with tasks such as:

- Helping you to understand complex documents and reports
- Listening to your views and concerns and supporting you to clarify your thoughts
- Supporting you to complete paperwork
- Putting you in touch with relevant agencies
- Attending meetings with you to ensure your views are heard
