General Course Information

Through the Live Music Performance, you will have the opportunity to develop the following skills:

- Perform effectively on your instrument / voice
- Rehearse and display musicianship skills
- Initiate and develop repertoire
- Understand contextual issues relating to music style, audience and the music industry

How is the course assessed?

The majority of the work on this course is internally marked coursework, focusing on live music performance, and musicianship skills. There is an externally marked Controlled Assessment focusing on rehearsing for and performing at a live event – this is the core unit.

Who's it for?

In order to achieve in this subject you will need 100% commitment; for most of the time you will be working in a band, and so will need excellent attendance.

It is not essential for you to have studied GCSE Music or the Rockscool Music Practitioner qualifications at Level 2. If you have not studied Music before, you will need to attend an informal interview with a teacher from the Music Department for them to ascertain your commitment, prior knowledge, skills and enthusiasm, and therefore suitability for the course.

Progression

We live in a fast moving world. The Access to Music/Rockscool qualifications will equip you with skills to take into the music industry but also into other areas, including further study at Higher Education. If you complete the Subsidiary Diploma at Distinction it is worth 72 UCAS points
