Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Following on from Government Guidance

You will have no doubt heard by now that among a range of measures announced last night, from Thursday Leicester Schools will be returning to the opening that we saw before 15th June. With the East side of the city reportedly one of the hardest hit areas in the city, we have taken the decision to implement these changes from today.

As of today, we will only be open to students whose parents are key workers or students who are themselves vulnerable.

All of the families affected by this today and tomorrow have been contacted individually but I wanted to let all of you know that these are the steps we have taken and that these steps will be in place until after the Summer Holiday.

I have no more information than you do currently, but I have heard that the guidance for school opening in September will be released towards the end of this week. The guidance will allow us to make plans for reopening after the summer and I will make sure to let you know what these plans will look like as soon as we have more information.

I know that the latest lockdown is very important to keep us safe but a number of families may find this news hard to take. If you have any concerns, then please contact the school and we will get back to you as soon as we can.

In the meantime, stay safe and I will be in touch with you again soon.
