## Re: Parental Update on the End and Start of Term

It has been a busy and exciting term at The City of Leicester College, and I wanted to expand on Mr Vernon's recent letter with further details of the last day of term and first day back for you to make necessary arrangements.

## **End of the Summer Term**

The last day of the summer term is **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July**. This day will finish at **12:25pm** for all year groups. This day will be a non-uniform day with £1 donations going to our school's chosen charity. Students will still be expected to wear their lanyards and have all the equipment for their lessons. The 1005 bus has confirmed that they will collect students outside school at 12:45pm.

## **Start of the Autumn Term**

The first day of the autumn term is **Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> August.** The start times will be slightly staggered to allow Year 7 a longer induction to that of the other year groups. We aim to then get students into their subject lessons as quickly as possible.

Please see below for what time students need to arrive on the first day, and which entrance to use.

Year Group	Time	Entrance
Year 7	08:30am	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their new tutors. The entrance will be open at 08:15am.
Year 8	09:15am	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:15am.
Year 9	09:15am	Arrive at the community entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:15am.
Year 10	09:15am	Arrive at the main entrance to meet their tutors. The entrance will be open at 09:15am.
Year 11	09:15am	Arrive at the side entrance (at the top of the outside steps). The entrance will be open at 09:15am.

## **Term Dates**

Please see attached our term dates for the 2023/2024 academic year. Please note, in addition to the Leicester City Council published dates we have additional staff inset days on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November, Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November and Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November.
