Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: NUT FREE SCHOOL

Can we please remind you we are a nut free school.

We have several children who have very serious nut allergies that can develop into a potentially life-threatening allergic reaction. For this reason, all nut-based products are not allowed on the school grounds.

An allergic reaction or anaphylaxis can occur as a result of digestion, inhalation or any other contact with nut-based products.

Please remember to check the labels of all food and even if it says may contain nuts, then please do not send that food product into school. For example:

- Spreads, e.g. chocolate spreads like Nutella
- Cereal bars
- Chocolate bars e.g. Kinder Bueno
- Biscuits
- Cakes containing nuts
- Condiments e.g. sauces

Please note, if a member of staff notices a pupil eating a nut product, the product will be removed politely and explain why this has been done.

So please can we reiterate that you have no nut products or products that may contain traces of nuts in the lunch boxes of the students or brought into the school as treats.

We thank you for your ongoing support and co-operation regarding this matter.
