**Re: Year 11 Study Leave June 2024**

As you will be aware this year's exam season begins on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May and will continue until Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June, with contingency days running until Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June.

I wanted to make you aware of some upcoming dates and events.

Thursday 9 <sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> May	<b>Normal lessons to continue when not in exams.</b> Where the exams for that subject have been completed the students will continue to attend these lessons and revise for upcoming exams.
Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> May at 11:25am (Period 3)	<b>Leavers Assembly in the Main Hall.</b> Shirt signing will take place following the leavers assembly. Students' must remember to bring a spare shirt as full school uniform will still be required for the remaining exams.
Thursday 23 <sup>rd</sup> May at 12:25pm	<b>Start of Study Leave.</b> From this date students will only be expected to attend school for their exams and for lessons where their exams have not been completed.
Mon 27 <sup>th</sup> May to Friday 31 <sup>st</sup> May	<b>Half Term Holiday</b>
Wednesday 19 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Final Exams - Food Preparation and Nutrition / Further Maths</b>
Thursday 20 <sup>th</sup> June to Wednesday 26 <sup>th</sup> June	<b>Contingency Days -</b> These dates are set by the exam board should any exams need to be rescheduled.
Friday 28 <sup>th</sup> June at 7:00pm to 11:00pm	<b>Year 11 Leavers Prom -</b> Final payments are now due for those wanting to attend.
Thursday 22 <sup>nd</sup> August	<b>Exam Results Day -</b> More information will be sent closer to the time.

**REMINDER: FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN ON THE SCHOOL SITE.**

**After their final exam, there will be a drop-off area in the main foyer for any students who would like to donate their school tie and/or school blazer. Your help would be appreciated.**

Student expectations from Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May will be as follows.

- Students will attend school for all exams.
- **For morning exams, they should attend tutor time as normal to register** and then go to their exam for 9:00am.
- **For afternoon exams where they have no lessons in the morning, they should arrive at 1:10pm** prompt and their register mark will be taken from the exam.
- Attend school for lessons where students have not taken their final exam in that subject.
- If they have a gap between exams or lessons during the day, students can either go off site or go to the designated study area/room for independent revision. (e.g. Normal lesson period 1 then nothing until the afternoon exam, period 2 and 3 can be spent in the study area where they will be required to sign in.)
