Course Outline for Key Stage 3

The New KS3 curriculum is launching in September 2021. This will be the first time a wide range of exciting new projects have been taught at TCOLC. Our vision for Art & Design Technology is that everyone IS creative! We believe that all students should have an opportunity to discover and develop this creativity for themselves. The KS3 curriculum has been designed to give all students a strong foundation for continuing the subjects at KS4 and 5.

Due to the COVID restrictions in 2020/2021 students haven't had any practical experience in ADT. In the following 2 years projects will develop further to ensure breadth and depth knowledge and practical skills are covered.
