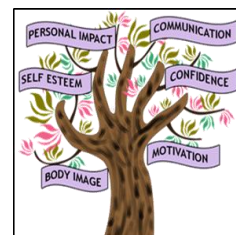


KS3 PSHE

Programme of study

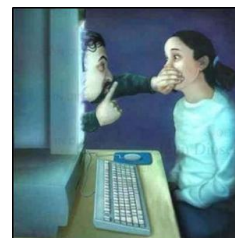
