Yr11 – 12 Transition Activities

Subject: Fine Art



<u>Fine Art Transition work over the Summer holiday – Due in on</u> the first Fine Art lesson.

Tasks: Buy, alter a book/brochure or create a handmade sketchbook using a range of materials and papers found in your household, from the recycling bag:

- Collate a minimum of 10 sheets at A4/A5 size, maximum of 20 pages
- Ensure you use both textured and printed materials, not just clean white sheets of envelopes, brown paper, inside of crisp packets, cereal boxes etc.
- Make the outside covers out of a thicker material like corrugated card, cereal box, wood, plastic on the front and back of the sketchbook
- Feel free to use white paper, watercolour paper, fabrics, wallpaper, brown paper, newspaper, maps, leaflets coming through the post; work on top of the pages which will be more challenging but interesting etc.
- Don't worry if the pages are different sizes, this makes the tasks more interesting.
- Respond to the range of tasks on the slides in a creative, exciting & personalised manner.

How to present?

- A personal preference is that you string the pages together; refer to the Youtube links
 on the PowerPoint for details, you could concertina (fold the long paper back and forth);
 or use a bulldog clip; staples; cello tape; elastic bands; string; or use nuts and bolts (to
 make it look industrial), entirely your choice if the book is handmade.
- From the list of ideas for observational drawing, select and draw a series of sketches
 and (present some drawings in colour) a minimum of 4-6 different topics, one topic per
 page or per double page, showing several of hand drawn sketches, using a range of
 media, or mixed media. Show experimentation, creativity, inspiration and a personal
 response alongside a series of observational drawings.

What to include?

- A sketchbook; recycled, altered or handmade at A4/A5 size
- Show a combination of drawings, paintings, collages and text/words to illustrate the suggested themes using a range of materials techniques and processes
- Select any 4-6 topics to draw as Observational drawings from the given list
- Include some photography as primary evidence for portraiture or still life drawings
- Complete artist analysis for a minimum of two artist whose work influenced you, from the list given or select your own artist to work from.
- Attend a couple of virtual art exhibitions at one of the given galleries/museums
