Many of the units will be delivered in an integrated manner. The work is very student centred and although there will be some lectures and note-taking much of the work will involve students finding information out for themselves. The 'business world' will be used as much as possible and there may be further supported by work placements, industrial visits, possible residential trips and relevant speakers during delivery of units. There will also be considerable use of I.T to support assignment writing and assessment will take the form of coursework, practical role plays, pro-forma sheets, formal examination and controlled assessments.

There will be a number of assignments set which will enable students to demonstrate their understanding of different topics. These assignments will be graded (Pass, Merit, Distinction) with an opportunity to re-submit work to improve overall grades.

Pass (equivalent to Grade E)

Merit (equivalent to Grade C)

Distinction (equivalent to Grade A)

Distinction*(equivalent to Grade A*)

WHO'S IT FOR?

The most important thing you need in order to take the BTEC in Business is a lively and enquiring mind, an interest in business, a willingness to explore new ideas and an ability to communicate your ideas effectively.

The minimum requirement will normally be four grade C's at G.C.S.E. of which two should be Mathematics and English language. Alternatively, a Merit or above at BTEC First Business.
